Privacy and Data Protection Policy for Online Assignments

- 3. **Payment Processing**: To manage course fees, refunds, and financial records.

- 5. **Legal Compliance**: To fulfil legal and regulatory obligations and protect our rights.

5. Lawful Basis for Processing Data

We process personal data based on the following lawful bases:

- 1. **Performance of a Contract**: To provide and manage your EFL course, fulfilling our obligations as a service provider.
- 2. **Consent**: When you have given clear consent for us to process your data (e.g., for marketing purposes).
- 3. **Legitimate Interests**: Where processing is necessary for the legitimate interests of Online Assignments (e.g., service improvement) and does not override your rights.
- 4. **Legal Obligations**: When required to comply with legal obligations (e.g., accounting and tax requirements).

6. Data Sharing and Disclosure

Online Assignments will not share, sell, or disclose your personal data to third parties except in the following situations:

- 6. **Objection to Processing**: Object to processing based on legitimate interests or for direct marketing.
- 7. **Withdraw Consent**: Withdraw consent where processing is based on consent (e.g., marketing).
